

About YACSA's Governance Structure

Being actively involved in YACSA's Policy Council means that you will have the opportunity to:

- Contribute to the peak body for youth affairs in South Australia
- Increase your knowledge of the youth sector and the broader issues around youth affairs
- Make contacts with other members and people working in the youth sector
- Participate in policy decisions affecting young people in South Australia
- Organise and participate in working groups and forums
- Help set the strategic directions of YACSA

YACSA has a **Policy Council**, which is drawn from its membership. There are 12 individual representatives (including young people) and a representative from each affiliated youth worker network. The full Policy Council meets every eight weeks and discusses issues of policy and strategic direction.

The **Management Committee** is elected by the Policy Council to oversee the financial, staffing policy and accountability functions of YACSA. Members hold positions for a one year term (three years for office bearers) and meet once every four weeks.
