Young Victims' Support Services

Some of the services that are available to young people in South Australia are as follows:

The Second Story (TSS) Youth Health Centres

The Second Story can be contacted on 1300 13 17 19 or at any of these addresses:

Central - 57 Hyde Street, Adelaide,

North - Gillingham Street, Elizabeth.

South - 50A Beach Road, Christies Beach, West - 51 Bower Street, Woodville.

Helps young people aged 12 – 25 years. The Youth Health Line at Second Story encourages all young people to call; particularly those who may want to talk to someone about what is going on in their life but feel more at ease with a telephone conversation than with face-to-face contact.

The Yarrow Place Rape and Sexual Assault Service

Address: Level 2, Norwich Centre, 55 King William Road, North Adelaide.

Helps people aged 16 years and over with counselling, medical and information services - for people who have experienced rape or sexual assault who were aged 16 years or over at the time of the assault. There is no police involvement with the service and clients do not have to report the assault to access the services.

Kumangka Aboriginal Youth Service

Helps Aboriginal and Torres Strait identified young people 12-25 years.

Services

- Advocacy for young people with police, family and legal services
- Case management for young people at risk
- Counselling
- Crisis intervention
- Information and referral - health, counselling, accommodation, education and training services
- Kumangka-Reconnect - early intervention for young Indigenous people at risk of homelessness
- Streetwork program - youth workers are available on Friday and Saturday nights in the inner city area

Kids Helpline

Helps young people 5-25 years with anonymous and confidential counselling.

Child Abuse Report Line

Can be contacted on 131478 at any time.

Helps anyone who wishes to report child abuse.

Crisis Care

Can be contacted on 13 1611 after hours.

Helps anyone needing crisis information. Qualified social workers and trained volunteers handle all calls. Crisis care is available 4pm till 9 am on weekdays and 24 hours on weekends and public holidays.
